The on-call time is skewed, due to labor laws requiring he be paid for 2 hours minimum even if he's only there for 30 minutes.

Motion to approve and recommend at \$181,917.00, Herb, Second: Dennis Discussion: Mike states that the amount recommended was the BOS total, which includes a 4% increase in wages not the 6% asked for by the Library Trustees. Brian states that the Trustees can increase the part-time wages and we will then probably see this increase in next year's budget. Carina states that the BOS decided that if there was a position that needed to have a wage increase it needed to be looked at individually, not collectively and therefore gave a 4% increase to all employees. Carina states that the new cleaning contract went from \$19,500.00 to \$22,100.00, which would the total to \$184,517.00. Motion to increase the total to \$184,517.00, Tracey, Second: Brent. Carina states that the BOS have not voted on that amount yet. Brian states that since the library underspent last year, the Trustees could increase the pay using the surplus. Carina states that their surplus this year is \$8,153.00, which gives them plenty of room to increase the part-time wages by the \$2,400.00. Budget committee tables this budget until Thursday so the BOS can vote on the total first. Tracey withdraws the motion.

Mike states this is a one-year issue and it's not worth spending the extra money. Carina states that if the current vendor will not approve July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, then they will put it out to bid right away, but we need to expect to pay double.

Cindy states there is a great liability in not doing the stairs. Paul makes a motion to amend the amount to \$30,000.00, Second: Brent. Discussion: Wayne states that the amount was already decreased from \$70,000.00 to \$62,000.00 based on using granite instead of concrete. Paul states more money could be taken from other budgets if the project ends up being more. Other estimates need to be obtained. Carina states the stairs need to be done this year.
