Library Director Carol Riley and Chairwoman of the Trustees Gail Tremblay representing 80 the LIBRARY ask that we reconsider the proposed budget that was Trustees presented. The 81 BOS recommended \$129,668.00, which included a 3% cost of living increase to put them in 82 line with the rest of Town employees. The Trustees proposed \$1 increase to salaries and 83 an additional night employee. They believe that the one time increase of \$1 (\$2500.00 84

added to wages) is necessary for their employees. They also feel the \$10,140.00 for 85 86 another night person is necessary for security. Ms. Tremblay then read from the NH Library Associations Association Trustee Manual. OJ states that The Budget Committees 87 budget goes to Town Meeting. The Library Trustees then use that bottom line as they see 88 fit. At Town meeting, anyone can vote to raise a budget, as long as it doesn't go above the 89 10% limit.
