What is Fuel Assistance?

Fuel Assistance is a seasonal program designed to help eligible households afford the high cost of heating their homes. Tri-County CAP receives federal LIHEAP funds through the State of NH Governor's Office of State Planning & Energy. Benefits can be used toward delivered heating fuels as well as electricity & rent when the heat is included (provided it is not subsidized housing). The program funds are generally available around the beginning of December & last until April 30th.

What is needed to apply?

The most vulnerable households, those with elderly or disabled members, or families with young children are prioritized. The general public can apply after September 1st. Each household must complete an application, providing information about each household member & income documentation. This information is confidential & is used to determine eligibility & benefit amounts. When you call to make an appointment, you will be told what to bring for documentation.
