During the year I serviced the following calls:

- Mold in residence, condos, and businesses
- Trash-build up
- Health and welfare of children
- Various complaints about insect infestation
- Food complaints
- Several interior living conditions complaints
- Complaints of exterior conditions that may result in health problems
- Inspections of day care facilities
- Wild cats complaints
- Condemning of a building due to skunks
- Concerns of sewage

Any animal complaint should be referred to the animal control officer.

A reminder that Spring is coming and to remove your bird feeders early so as not to entice the bears. Also keep your trash confined in metal containers. You don't want an encounter with a bear!
