Summer Soccer Camp:

GOALS GALORE: Directed by Shawn Griffin, former PSC Head Soccer Coach and current Head Coach at Hobart College in Geneva, NY. Will be offered from **June 16th – 20th**, at Lin-Wood Community Ball Field (new field at the school), for ages 5-14 . It will run from 9am–11:30am , and the cost is \$85 for the week. Every Player will receive a camp soccer ball, a camp t-shirt, and quality soccer training instruction for the week. Registration is necessary, so please sign up early!





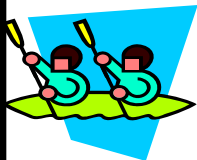
“Kanc Kids Kamp”:



This year’s day camp program will run from **June 23rd– August 15th**. “Kanc Kamp” is for kids that are 5 years old through 9 years of age, and is held at the Kanc Recreation Area from 9 am – 3 pm Monday – Friday. The first 4 week session will run from June 23rd – July 18th. The second session will run from July 21st– August 15th. Registration will be at the Recreation Office, 8am – 4pm, Monday – Thursday from June 2nd – June 12th. The registration fee is \$70 per camper per session, or \$120 for both sessions, and must be paid at that time. The session registration fee covers 4 weeks of camp, but does not include field trip fees. After the June 12th deadline the cost is \$8 per day for drop in participants, or they can register for the second session. These rates are for residents of either Lincoln or Woodstock. The rates for people that do not live in either Lincoln or Woodstock, but work in one of the two towns is \$60 per week per camper, or \$10 a day drop in rate. Drop in rates are not for more than 3 days, and can not be used for all 5 days of camp. If you have any questions, please call the Rec. Department!

Summer “Adventure Camp”:

The new Adventure Camp program is for **10-14 year olds**, and will be held at the Father Roger Bilodeau Community Center from Monday to Friday from **9:00 am- 3:00 pm**. The camp will include hiking, swimming, a skate park visit, frisbee golf, kayaking, and will run from **June 23rd** until **August 15th**. The registration fee is \$70 per camper per session, or \$120 for both sessions, and must be paid at registration. The first 4 week session will run from June 23rd – July 18th. The second session will run from July 21st– August 15th. The session registration fee covers 4 weeks of camp, but does not include field trip fees. Registration will be at the Recreation Office, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, Monday – Thursday from June 4th – June 14th. After the June 14th deadline the cost is \$8 per day for drop in participants, or they can register for the second session. These rates are for residents of either Lincoln or Woodstock. The rates for people that do not live in either Lincoln or Woodstock, but work in one of the two towns is \$60 per week per camper, or \$15 a day drop in rate. 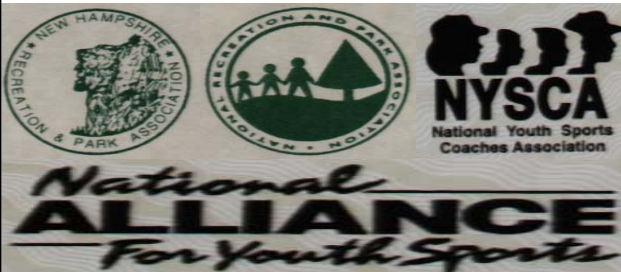


Lincoln-Woodstock Coalition for a Healthy Community:
