

**Lincoln Board of Selectmen
Public Meeting Minutes
April 29, 2008
5:30 pm**

Present: Chairman Deanna Huot, Selectman Peter Moore, Selectman Patricia McTeague, and Town Manager Ted Sutton.

At 5:30 pm, a **motion** was made by Selectman Moore, seconded by Selectman McTeague, to enter into **non-public session** per RSA 91-A:3 II(b). The vote was unanimous. The Board interviewed one applicant for the Town Manager position. A decision was made to set up a meeting with the finalists for the position with Department Heads and Board Chairs at 6pm on Monday, May 12, 2008, and open meeting with the public at 6pm on Monday May 19, 2008. At 7:15 pm, a **motion** was made by Selectman Moore, seconded by Selectman McTeague, to reconvene the public session. The decision was unanimous.

The Board next discussed Town Policy toward the Father Roger Bilodeau Community Center tenants, the Grafton County Senior Citizens Council and Lincoln Woodstock Community Childcare Center, regarding use of the facility for their fundraising events. The fee structure has been established for all groups in every category, but it was decided that because of the special circumstances of the building's tenants, that they will be allowed one free use annually for the purpose of fundraising.

The refrigerator in the facility belongs to the Grafton County Senior Citizens Council, and there is a definite need for a second refrigerator for the Father Roger Bilodeau Community Center's purposes.
