The pantry is currently operated by the Lincoln-Woodstock Recreation Department. However, aside from providing staff time and facility space for the pantry, it is not a tax-supported program. The pantry is not funded through Lincoln or Woodstock and therefore depends on the generosity of our fellow townspeople for all donations.

The goal of the pantry is to provide a service that it will supplement the basic needs of our community members. This is accomplished by working in conjunction with local agencies, businesses, and churches to provide needed materials and donations.

Monetary donations made to the Lincoln-Woodstock Food Pantry are exclusively used to purchase food and other needed items including; bread, meats, fruits, vegetables, baby food, formula, diapers, cereal, pasta, dairy products, and toiletries.
