NOTICE OF DECISION

Zoning Board of Adjustment

RE: Case No. 11-02 – Lincoln Woodstock Community Child Care Center - PO Box 965 Lincoln NH 03251

The application submitted by Lincoln Woodstock Community Child Care Center, for a Special Exception Pursuant to Article VI-B, Section D10 of the Town of Lincoln Land Use Plan Ordinance – Lincoln Sign Ordinance - was **DENIED**, on April 13th, 2011 by a vote of the Zoning Board of Adjustment.

The reasons for denial were as follows (agree-disagree-abstain):

- 1) Project is Architecturally Compatible: Agree (4-0-0)
- 2) Project will not affect traffic access: Agree (4-0-0)
- 3) Projects Lighting and Noise Levels will not Disturb the Tranquility of the District: Agree (4-0-0)
- 4) The Project is Compatible with Existing Uses: **Disagree (**4-0-0)
 - a. The Board found that the applicant did not meet requirement #4 necessary to grant the special exception. The Board found that the sign would not be compatible with the businesses currently located within the Rural Residential District who abide by the 9 sq. ft. sign dimensional requirement.

Notice: The Board of Selectmen or any party to the action or any person directly affected has a right to appeal this decision up to 30 days from the date of this notice.
