NEW BUSINESS

Grafton County Tax for 2021:

The town received notice that County Taxes for 2021 in the amount of \$1,759,266 are due by December 17, 2021. [Note: 2020 County Appropriation = \$1,718,351]

Report of the Committee to Review Authorizing Governing Bodies of Municipalities to Hold Virtual Meetings *Pursuant to RSA 91-A*:

Selectman Ham referenced a recent report from the State of NH recommending all public bodies establish rules of procedures for conducting remote meetings (e.g., minimum number of people [2 or more] required to be physically present; how many remote members be counted toward the quorum requirement, and, procedures for conducting hybrid meetings). Ham suggested this be put on a future agenda.

Town-wide Mask Mandate

Ivan Strickon submitted data and information to the board on the rising COVID numbers in the community, and is requesting the board institute a town-wide mask mandate.

OLD BUSINESS:

Rodger Harrington – Lincoln Police Department

Selectman Ham followed up on last weeks' discussion with Rodger Harrington concerning an incident that occurred with a Lincoln Police Officer. Ham explained that she met with Chief Morris about this matter and was told that any personnel issues are handled in-house. Selectman Daly asked if Chief Morris had agreed to meet with Mr. Harrington to get his version of events. Ham responded that it is her understanding that Chief Morris has already met with Mr. Harrington, and any disciplinary actions would not be publicly disclosed information to Mr. Harrington or anyone else.

Jim Welsh commented that he thought the new Town Manager was going to be present tonight. Ham responded that Carina Park zooming in to a board meeting depends upon her current employment, as her board meets bi-weekly and she may have had other work-related business.
