The Rope Tow SKI SLOPE hours are:

Monday - Thursday (Fridays starting in Feb.) 3:00 - 5:00 p.m.

Saturday & Sundays 10:00 am - 12:00 pm & 1:00 p.m. -3:00 p.m.

Nights—Fridays & Saturdays 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. (once conditions allow)

December Vacation (12/26-1/2) week Hours: 10:00 am - 12:00 pm & 1:00 p.m. -3:00 p.m.

This year only season passes will be sold, and they will only be available at: http://linwood.recdesk.com.*

*If you had a season pass last year, and still have your key tag, it will be re-activated with your purchase of this year's pass.

Passes will only be sold until: December 10th

Resident Season Pass Rates: Individual: \$30.00 & Family: \$75.00*

Non-Resident Season Pass Rates: Individual: \$100 & Family: \$250*

*Must be immediate family members that either reside in the same household, or are claimed as a dependent for tax purposes.



Other requirements:

- The building will be closed! You will need to use your car as your "locker", and put all of your equipment on at your car.
- The sledding hill is closed again this year, because of the need for increased parking.
 - We will not open if temperatures are below 10 degrees, or if it is raining.
- Bathroom access will be around the back of the building, and there will be a walk-up/ski-up window for pre-packaged concession sales.
- The hill will be closed when we reach capacity for that shift. (Increased capacity to 100 this year).
- For the safety of our staff and guests, please DO NOT come skiing if you have any symptoms of COVID-19, if you have been in close contact with someone with COVID-19, or if you have been told to quarantine due to exposure.
 - At the entrance to the ski area you will need to have your pass scanned, and you can then
 head directly to the rope tow loading area.
 - Guests will be required to wear a cloth face covering over their mouth and nose when at check-in, when using the restrooms, or when in public locations where it is not possible to maintain 6 feet of physical distance from others not in your family/ group.
